

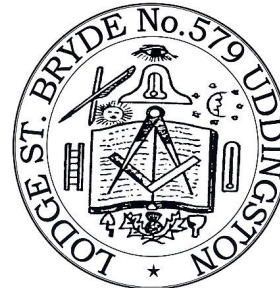

New Temple Dedication. Bob Law, Past District Grand Master reports that recently, a near dormant Lodge Scotia No. 973 was revived in the town of Virginia in the Free State. The Lodge moved from Johannesburg and several Brethren from Bloemfontein and Virginia and the surrounding area affiliated to the newly located Lodge Scotia and purchased a building in the shopping centre in the town and refurbished it as their Temple. 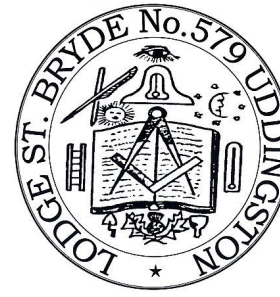

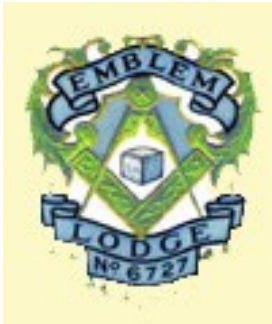
