

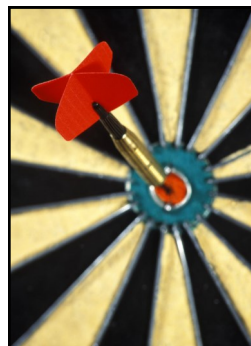
Gettysburg Masonic Memorial
