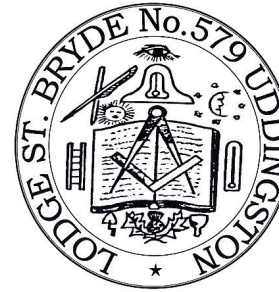

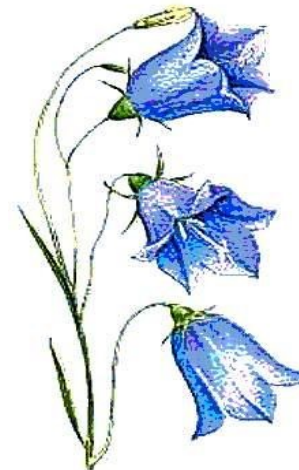

District of Central South Africa News.

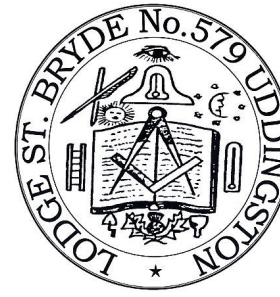
