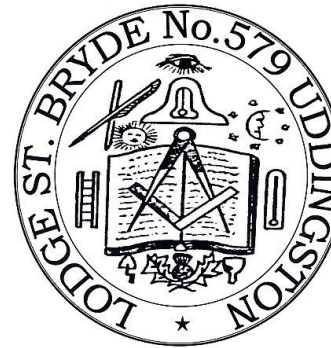


### Arran Visit.
