Important Information Wanted.

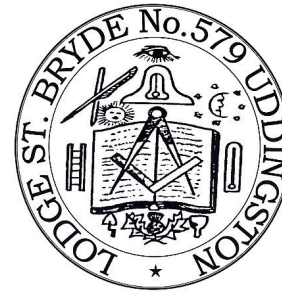
