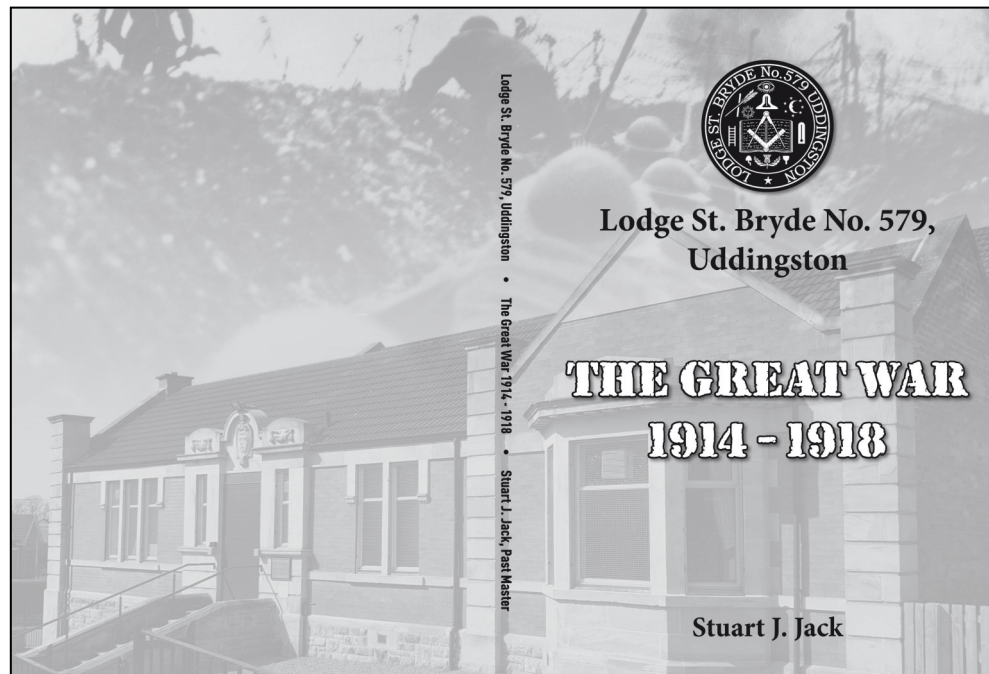

Above : The Book Cover

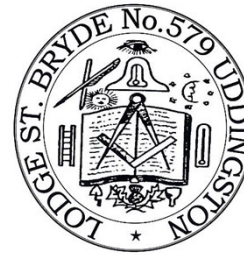

Historical Find !

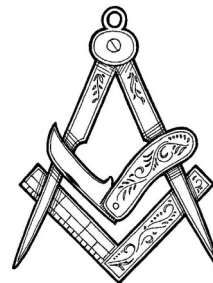

The Conference will take place in Freemasons Hall and will conclude with the Installation and Festival of St. Andrew on Thursday 24th. November and a Special Supreme Royal Arch Meeting in Freemasons Hall on Friday 25th. November. The cost of

attending the Conference (excluding the Festival of St. Andrew) is £150 for Early Bird Registration (1st. March to 30th. April), £200 for Standard Registration (1st. May to 10th. October) and £120 for a Day Pass Registration (The Conference will be limited to 300 attendees.)
