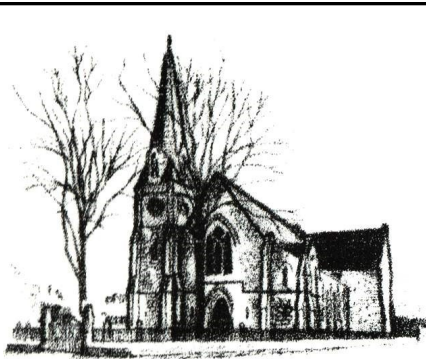

Lodge St. Bryde News.

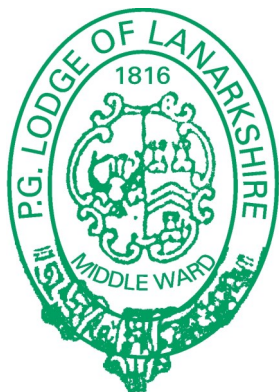

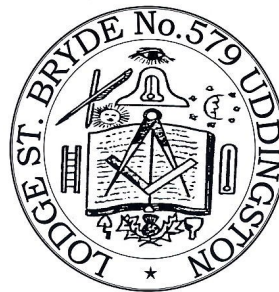
Lodge St. James` Operative No. 97, Edinburgh.
