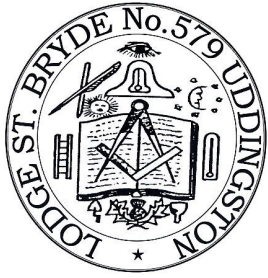

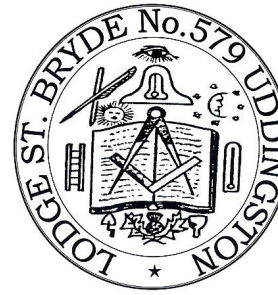
**Lodge St. Bryde News.**

**James McCall Brown**

In the September issue of *The Right Angle*, Bro. Stuart Jack, IPM updated the readers on his World War 1 research. He had discovered important information on Bro. James McCall Brown who was Initiated in 14th. November 1917 after being discharged from the army, having been severely wounded twice. He discovered that he had emigrated to Ontario, Canada and had died (probably from the result of his wounds) two years later, leaving a young wife and three small children.



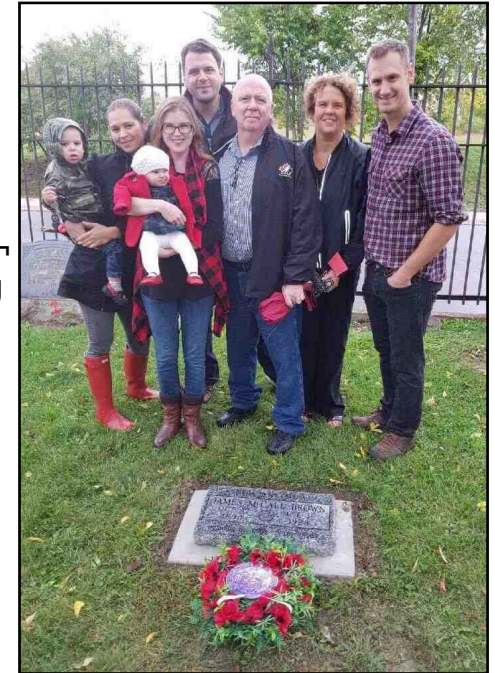
Remarkably, Stuart managed to make contact with members of Bro. Browns family, still living in the Ontario area. They managed to establish where he was buried and also the fact that the grave was not marked. The family immediately set about raising funds for a marker and Lodge St. Bryde sent a donation of £100. The Lodge also sent a wreath which was to be placed on the

grave when the marker was put in position. On Sunday 15th. October 2017 in a quiet corner of a Windsor Cemetery a lone piper played and the family placed our wreath on our Brothers grave. **Annual General Meeting**

At Annual General Meeting on 11th. October the Accounts were approved and the general opinion was that the Lodge have had a very successful financial year. In fact a very successful year all round. The Fund Raising was an exceptional effort by all the Brethren that took part and contributed greatly to the external restoration being completed within the year. The Secretary presented a summary of the Lodge position and the Brethren unanimously agreed that fund raising would be ongoing and that the Standing Order Scheme be highlighted as an excellent way of paying Lodge dues as well as making donations. The Lodge also agreed a forward plan, which would start with an inspection of the property by Rentokil who carried out a similar task ten years ago. An increase in Lodge Fees was approved and this will take immediate effect. The Office-bearers for the 2017-18 Session were Elected and Bro. Duncan Mulholland received the unanimous support of the Brethren and was elected as Right Worshipful Master for the ensuing year.
