### Provincial Grand Lodge.

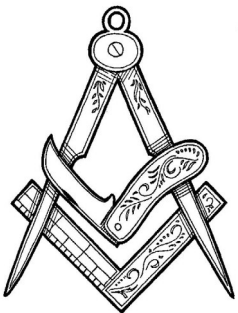

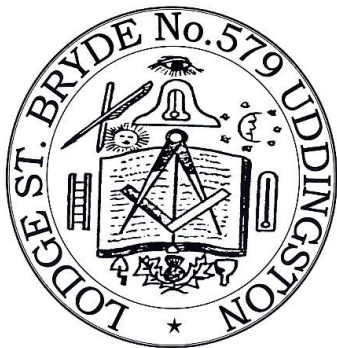
