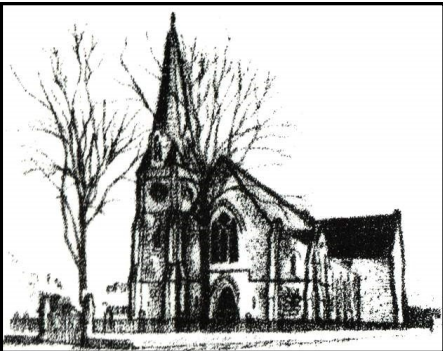

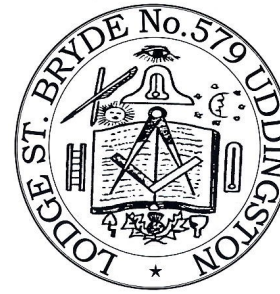
Bro. Jack is an Honorary Senior District Grand Warden of The District of The Bahamas.

Main Hall Floor

As part of the ongoing work to keep our Masonic Hall in excellent condition, the annual floor refurbishment was carried out by a specialist contractor. The annual refurb work is necessary to keep on top of wear and minor damage. As the floor can not be further sanded, it is

essential that great care is taken when moving Lodge furniture tables and chairs as damage to the floor can not be repaired. The contractor has told us that the floor is one of the best that he has seen and cannot be replaced. Treat it with respect, it nearly 100 years old. It was laid by Bro. John Junor, who resigned as Junior Warden of the Lodge as he was called up for service in World War 1.
