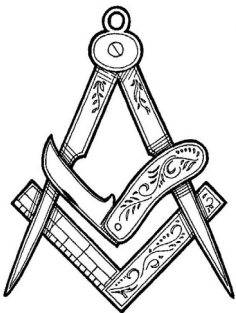

Lodge Randolph No. 1413.

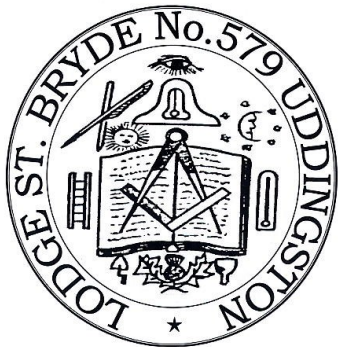

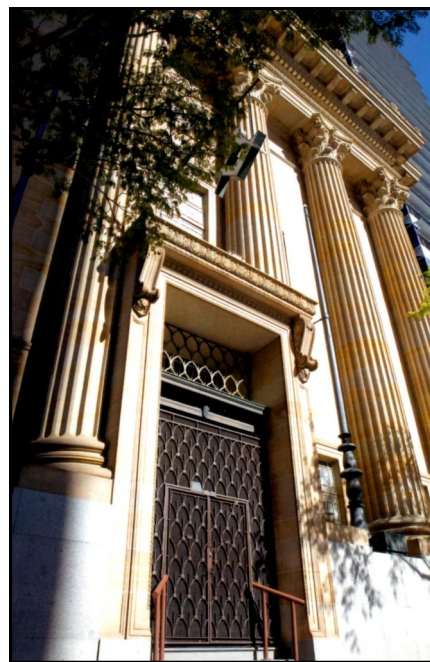
Lodge St. Bryde visits.
