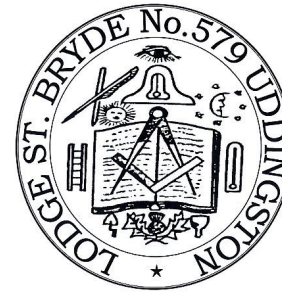
ALL PROCEEDS TO POPPY SCOTLAND

Report on the Third International Scottish Masonic Conference.

15th. to 19th. May 2019, Nassau, Bahamas.

The Third Conference was held in the Atlantis Resort, Paradise Island, The Bahamas between 15th. And 19th. May 2019 and was hosted by The District Grand Lodge of The Bahamas.

The theme of the Conference was “Unity from Diversity” and included speakers drawn from the Delegates from the twenty-three countries represented. In fact, the attendance was exceptional, with four hundred Brethren and Ladies present, including thirteen District Grand Masters and The Grand Master of The Grand Lodge of Victoria. The Grand Lodge of Scotland was represented by, M.W. Bro. W. Ramsay McGhee, Grand Master Mason, R.W. Bro. J. Euan Edment, Grand Secretary, R.W. Bro. James L. Jack, Grand Bard and R.W. Bro. Tom Davidson, Grand Standard Bearer. In his opening address, The Grand Master Mason that he hoped those attending the Conference would learn something new and actively participate in the planned sessions and leave the Conference having been motivated and encouraged to return to their respective Lodges and Districts and in turn motivate the Brethren who were unable to attend.



The programme of events included a formal meeting with Her Excellency, Dame Marguerite Pindling, Governor General, The Deputy Prime Minister and Attorney General of The Bahamas who were very supportive of the planned events. The Brethren of the Grand Lodge Deputation visited the site of new Scottish Masonic Centre which is under construction by The District Grand Lodge and The Grand Master Mason planted a commemorative tree to mark the event. The Conference Sessions were Chaired by R.W. Bro. Charles Johnson, Past District Grand Master and included the new administrative and financial procedures and policy, presented by Grand Secretary. Meetings between the G.M.M. and D.G.M. 's and Secretaries and Treasurers. Bro. James L.
